We're very excited that you've decided to apply for this year's Discover Summer Academy! The application portal you are about to enter is the main platform we use to collect information from applicants and participants, and to notify you of changes to the status of your application. Only the Student Care Team can see your whole application, including personal details.

Your first step will be to fill in the application form, which takes less than 20 minutes. You can find a preview of the whole application here. Please bear in mind that **this application is for international sessions (D and E) only.**

Here are some things to keep in mind before you go forward. Be sure to:

think about

- what courses you will choose as your preferences (four in total). We will let you know which two of the four you will be attending at the end of June;
- what your motivation for signing up for Discover, and for attending the four courses you chose, is;
- how high a fee you will pay if you are offered a place the standard fee for the international session is 299 Euros / 7299 Kč for session E or 329 Euros / 7999 Kč for session D. You can also pay more if you're able to support us, or apply for a reduced fee if you cannot afford the standard fee (we offer full scholarships). Please note that scholarship applications close on 15th June 2024. If you wish to apply for a scholarship after 15th June, please contact us at scholarships@discover.sk.

remember that

- to be able to attend, you must be at least 15 and less than 21 years old and be a high school student for the 2023/2024 school year. That's it, there are no other requirements!
- the application is divided into several sections and your answers will be saved as each section is completed. You can only move on to the next section after you have completed the previous one. For a preview of the whole application, click here.

If you do not choose a secondary session and the international session of your choosing is full at the time we review your application, you will automatically be transferred to a waiting list. If a spot opens, we will choose students from the waiting list based on two criteria - the date of submission of your application and the grade that it received. All waitlisted applicants will receive an update on their waiting list status by the end of June at the latest.

Section 2/4: Course selection (3 minutes)

Most students are assigned to their first and second course preferences, but unfortunately this is not always possible for everyone.

Participant fee

This year's participation fee is 329 € / 7999 Kč for session D, and 299 € / 7299 Kč for session E (payments are accepted in Euros or Czech Crowns only). If your situation does not allow you to pay the full fee, we offer full and partial scholarships. We also offer you the option to pay a slightly higher fee to support the development of Discover.

The fee covers the costs of: accommodation and 5 meals a day for students, a first aid kit and materials/tools used during the session (e.g. office supplies, board games) and accommodation and meals for the organisers, who are volunteers who do not receive any financial reward for their year-long work on the preparation of Discover.

If your situation does not allow you to pay the full fee, we offer full and partial scholarships. Your scholarship application will be assessed by a committee of 2 to 3 members.
